Norris, 1992-01-01 In his foreword Arthur M Schlesinger Jr places the distinguished senator from a conservative state in the best liberal tradition **Fighting Liberal** George William Norris, 1966 *Fighting Liberal* George William Norris, 1961 The Education of an Anti-Imperialist Richard Drake, 2013-12-19 Robert M La Follette 1855 1925 the Republican senator from Wisconsin is best known as a key architect of American Progressivism and as a fiery advocate for liberal politics in the domestic sphere But Fighting Bob did not immediately come to a progressive stance on foreign affairs In The Education of an Anti Imperialist Richard Drake follows La Follette s growth as a critic of America s wars and the policies that led to them He began his political career with conventional Republican views of the era on foreign policy avidly supporting the Spanish American and Philippine American Wars La Follette s critique of empire emerged in 1910 during the first year of the Mexican Revolution as he began to perceive a Washington Wall Street alliance in the United States dealings with Mexico La Follette subsequently became Congress s foremost critic of Woodrow Wilson fiercely opposing United States involvement in World War I Denounced in the American press as the most dangerous man in the country he became hated and vilified by many but beloved and admired by others La Follette believed that financial imperialism and its necessary instrument militarism caused modern wars He contended they were twin evils that would have ruinous consequences for the United States and its citizens in the twentieth century and beyond An excellent book As Drake fully documents La Follette s warnings about World War I profiteers and the lust for power were fully justified Then as now the American people were lied to by the government and media and manipulated into the stink and blood of war Mark Taylor The Daily Call Scholars will value the insights into La Follette s foreign policy education The Historian **The Civil War Income Tax and the Republican Party, 1861-1872** Christopher Michael Shepard, 2010 A flat tax Tax cuts Complete elimination of the income tax These ideas have most certainly been advocated by members of the Republican Party during the past few decades Party leaders such as George W Bush Ronald Reagan and Newt Gingrich expressed disdain for the income tax and utilized their power to remove it as a revenue source At the time of the Civil War many Republicans mainly in the Northeast were opposed to the new Federal Income Tax Initially used to finance that war the Federal income tax became a hotly debated issue at a time when America was trying to put back together a fractured nation The issue split the party with Midwestern and Southern Republicans wanting to continue the income tax and Northern and Western Republicans championing its demise In the end the anti income tax wing took control of the Republican Party and shaped its economic principles for the future The book is an in depth look into how the Republicans in Congress dealt with the creation of the United States first income tax and how it affected the party for the future The author argues that the anti income tax faction of the Republican Party won the debate and took over the party and to this day the Republican Party typically promotes either cutting taxes or eliminating them altogether The author gives a brief history of the formation of the Republican Party

and how they developed their economic views in distinction from the declining Whig Party who mostly sought to fund the federal budget through tariffs and not by taxing the people directly The second half of the book looks at the different income tax legislations and how Republicans in Congress responded to them Each chapter begins with a brief historical context at the time when an income tax bill was being discussed in Congress The views of Republicans on the income tax were altered throughout the war and its aftermath In the beginning Republicans enthusiastically supported the income tax as a measure needed to sustain the fighting As the war came to a close however many Republicans began to change their view They originally backed progressive rates then they wanted just one flat tax rate and by 1870 many wanted the tax to be ended There was a divide in the Republican Party though Western Republicans wanted to keep the income tax intact while Northern Republicans called for its repeal The last chapter of the book looks at the Republican Party and the income tax since 1872 Many of the arguments made by current and past Republicans e g George W Bush Eisenhower Elihu Root and even Earl Warren against the income tax are shown to be the same ones made by many Republicans in the debate over the Civil War income tax Apparently the Northern anti income tax wing won the debate and took over the party 140 years ago
