The Law Society was chastised for its temerity in challenging legislation enabling harsh penalties to be imposed on the foreign press for interfering in the domestic politics of the island-state. More alarming, a plot was revealed which implicated Catholic social workers in an attempt to transform

Singapore into a classless society along Marxist lines. Finally, an American diplomat was expelled after being accused of seeking to promote and fund political opposition to the

Francis Seow, a legal practitioner and one-time Solicitor General of Singapore, was involved in one way or another with all three interconnected episodes. He was President of the Law Society, he defended two of the so-called Marxist plotters detained under the Internal Security Act and he was himself
