Such re-visions unsettle the cultural authority of the plays and expose the accumulated lore that surrounds them to probing often irreverent scrutiny. Much of the talking back comes from marginalized readers women like Lillie Wyman author of *Gertrude of Denmark An Interpretive Romance* and other nineteenth century women critics or Jewish writers like Arnold Wesker whose play *The Merchant* transforms the relationship between Antonio and Shylock. Some talking back comes from an international

collection of oppositional voices of the 1960s including Charles Marowitz Aime Cesaire Eugene Ionesco and Joseph Papp Talking Back to Shakespeare ranges from popular books like the recent Pulitzer Prize winning novel *A Thousand Acres* by Jane Smiley to obscure seldom read ones like Percy MacKaye's ambitious four play prequel *The Mystery of Hamlet King of Denmark*. What these published texts share with student journal entries and transformations is the assumption familiar to postmodern readers that Shakespeare's plays are essentially unstable culturally determined constructs capable of acquiring new meanings and new forms. By bringing together these two kinds of talking back Rozett challenges the traditional separation between critical and pedagogical inquiry that has until recently dominated English studies.
