Couched most often in terms of cognitive or information processing models, the general perspective of the contributors is a biologically based account of aging. This shared viewpoint gives the volume particular coherence in its treatment of theories and data. Topics covered include age differences in attention, perception, memory, knowledge, representation, reasoning and language as well as their neuropsychological and neurological correlates and practical implications.
