



Gothic Art and the Renaissance in Cyprus Camille Enlart, 1987 **Medieval Cyprus** Sabine Rogge, Michael Grünbart, 2015 In December 2012 a group of scholars met in Münster to present their recent studies on the multifaceted history and culture of medieval Cyprus and most of the papers presented at that conference are published in this volume. Several deal with the political history of the island: the reign of Isaakios Komnenos, the effects of the crusade of King Peter I in 1365, the so-called Ottoman Venetian war. An overview of the three volumes of the *Bullarium Cyprium* is given. Aspects of economic life in medieval Cyprus are treated in three papers: organisation, management and economic activities of monastic estates in the Middle Byzantine period; medieval cane sugar production on the island; the commerce between the islands of Cyprus, Majorca and Sardinia. Papers on a major ecclesiastical complex dating from the early 7th century on Cypriot artefacts of the 13th and 14th centuries used in daily life, on luxury metal objects from the Lusignan period and on some rather disparate elements of 15th-century architecture in Cyprus give insights into the material culture of medieval Cyprus. Furthermore, the topics of settlement patterns and insularity are treated in a paper on the successive relocations of the capital of the island of Cyprus from Late Antiquity to the Middle Ages. The book contains papers by Alexander Beihammer, Nicholas Coureas, Peter Edbury, Michael Grünbart, Michalis Olympios, Tassos Papacostas, Maria Parani, K. Scott Parker, Eleni Procopiou, Ulrike Ritzerfeld, Christopher Schabel, Marina Solomidou, Ieronymidou, Myrto Veiko and Joanita Vroom.

Pilgrims' Castle ('Atlit), David's Tower (Jerusalem) and Qal'at ar-Rabad ('Ajlun) C.N. Johns, Denys Pringle, 2019-05-23 First published in 1997, this collection includes papers on Crusader-era architecture in Palestine with a focus on Atlit, the castle of Ajlun, and on the Citadel of Jerusalem, both of which have previously been difficult to access. The volume is presented partly to repair the very real deficit in the literature on Crusader architecture and partly as a fitting memorial to the author who died in 1992. Atlit, in particular, held a special significance for C. N. Johns, being the site of his first major project as a field archaeologist. His *Guide to Atlit*, a masterly summary of his findings, remains the most complete and comprehensive account of the castle and its suburb. The studies collected here pay tribute to their author's enduring contribution to the medieval archaeology of the Near East. The first part of the book deals with the Pilgrim's Castle, the great Templar fortress and town at Atlit. The significance of Johns' excavations at this site has been relatively neglected because it remains in a military area inaccessible to visitors and because almost the entire stock of his major publication was lost in 1947. This *Guide to Atlit*, a synthesis of historical, archaeological and architectural research on the monument, is reprinted here together with all the interim reports relating to the medieval period. Also included are Johns' studies on the Citadel of Jerusalem, the Tower of David, and on the Islamic castle of Ajlun. Together they represent a fundamental contribution to the study of the period of the Crusades and to the military architecture of the Middle Ages. The notes by Denys Pringle bring the accounts up to date in the light of recent research. Byzantine Images and their Afterlives

Cypriot studies are represented by Michele Bacci and Maria Vassilaki, who examine aspects of form and style in architecture and icons. The final chapters by Jaroslav Folda, Anthony Cutler, Rossitza Schroeder, and Ann Driscoll are linked by their focus on the nature of copies and tease out the ways in which meaning is retained or altered and the role that is played by intent and reception.
