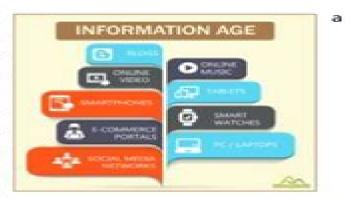
The Information Age Introduction
