It is the fourth in a series of comprehensive reviews of epidemiologic and toxicologic studies of the agents used as defoliants during the Vietnam War. Over forty health outcomes in veterans and their children are addressed. Among the reports conclusions is that there is sufficient evidence of a link between exposure and the development of soft tissue sarcoma, non Hodgkin's lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and chloracne in veterans. Additionally it found that scientific studies offer limited or suggestive evidence of an association with other diseases in veterans including Type 2 diabetes, respiratory cancers, prostate cancer, multiple myeloma and some forms of transient peripheral neuropathy as well as the congenital birth defect spina bifida in veterans children.
