GREEN COTTON

The cotton industry is experiencing a surge in popularity for **organic or green cotton**. As with any agricultural commodity there is great debate about how to produce cotton with the least impact on the environment. Some suggest sustainability will be achieved through genetically modified (GM) crops. GM cotton seeds (like Monsanto's **INGARD®**) are resistant to all natural pests and help reduce dependence on fertilizers, pesticides, and herbicides. 78% of U.S. cotton was genetically modified in 2000. Others argue that GM cotton crops are harmful to the rest of the food chain, as cottonseeds are incorporated into cattle feed.

Organic cotton crops, on the other hand, are crops where no GM seeds are used and no chemical fertilizers, pesticides, or herbicides are used. These plantations must be free of these chemical pest controls for 3 years and must satisfy certain

standards in order to use the term 'certified organic cotton'. Cotton that is picked but has little further processing (such as chlorine bleaching or chemical dyeing) is considered to be 'green' cotton. Conventional cotton production uses .45 kg (1 lb) of chemicals to produce 1.35 kg (3 lbs) of fabric.

Cotton can also be grown in different colors eliminating the need for dyeing, which is a very resource-intensive process. Cotton fibers can be grown in a full range of muted colors (achieving vibrant colors is still difficult) like mocha, tan, gray, red-brown, yellow, and green.

The green and organic cotton industries are experiencing rapid growth and expect an increase of 44% by 2008.
