Through an analysis of poetry, fiction, social and economic pamphlets, aesthetic treatises, journalism and correspondences placed within the latest queer historiography, Kavanagh demonstrates that the mid-century effeminacy crisis served to re-conceive male heterosexuality as the very mark of political legitimacy. Overall, *Effeminate Years* explores the development of modern ideas of masculinity and the political subject which are still the basis of debate and argument in our own time.
