

THE HUMAN GENOME - THE BLUEPRINT OF LIFE

The Human Genome project sequenced DNA, the molecules that make up chromosomes in cells. The information derived from this project武装ed scientists with a valuable opportunity to not only unlock the secrets of DNA but also the means by which genes are associated with disease. Scientists now are able to compare the genomes of people who have a certain condition with those who do not, in order to determine whether genetic variation plays a role in that condition. This information will help them to predict and possibly prevent disease in the future.



1. Cell

Each of the trillions of cells in the human body contains 46 chromosomes packed tightly into the region called the nucleus.

2. Chromosomes

Each of the chromosomes in the nucleus comes from your mother and half from your father. Each chromosome is a single, tightly coiled molecule called DNA, containing 3 billion units.

3. DNA

At conception, the DNA from all the chromosomes in a single cell unwinds and its spiral shape unravels into single strands.

4. Genome

DNA is made up of chemical building blocks abbreviated A, T, C, G, and T. The entire length of a DNA strand consists of these four blocks in different configurations. Together, all the DNA in all the chromosomes – more than 3 billion letters – makes up the human genome. When scientists say they have "sequenced" the human genome, this means that they have figured out the order of all those A's, T's, C's, G's, and T's in sequence.



6. Misspellings in the Sequence

One way that genes and "normal" alleles of the same gene can differ is by one or two changes in a gene's sequence. Since we know the normal sequence of the human genome, researchers can compare the DNA sequences from people who have a disease in relation to these reference points. If there are differences in the spelling of certain genes between the two groups, it's possible that the condition may be caused by a mutation in that misspelling in that gene.



5. Genes: 30,000 DNA Segments

Most of the DNA in the genome is composed into units called genes. There may be as many as 30,000 genes in the genome. These are the instructions required for creating all the proteins in our body. These proteins are the "worker" proteins that move us around from year to year, and move among other things. They have normal chemical reactions, regulate blood sugar and heart rate, and interact with food or medicine in metabolisms in the body.



7. Genes and Disease

Scientists have identified about 4,000 diseases, such as Huntington disease and cystic fibrosis, that are directly caused by misspellings or physical problems in single genes.

But that probably underestimates the many diseases conditions – such as diabetes and heart disease – is part of a larger puzzle that could include diet, exercise, environment, and many other genes. The study of these common conditions, called epidemiology, provides clues as to what contributes to disease relative to other factors, or ways to connect with them to reduce risks.
